

2017-18 West Virginia AmeriCorps National Competition Notice of Funding Opportunity

Volunteer West Virginia announces an opportunity for program funding via AmeriCorps State grants. Potential applicants will apply via a competitive process to operate an AmeriCorps program utilizing at least twenty AmeriCorps members to conduct direct service activities to create community change.

Eligible applicants are restricted to current West Virginia AmeriCorps programs receiving operational funding via either the National Competition or the West Virginia Formulary Award Process.

Volunteer West Virginia, the state's Commission for National and Community Service, challenges West Virginians to strengthen their communities through service and volunteerism. The Commission administers West Virginia's direct service AmeriCorps programs along with additional programming to help meet the state's volunteer and community service needs. Programs focus on Educational Support, Community Investment (service projects, historic and cultural preservation, and community development), Healthy Futures, Veterans and Military Families, Training (Grantwriting, Annual Volunteer Conference) and Disaster Services. Important Dates

- **Deadline #1:** Applications for new and re-competing programs are due **Wednesday, December 13, 2017 at 12:00 p.m. Eastern Time** to Volunteer West Virginia in eGrants.
- **Continuation Deadline:** Applications for continuation grants are due in eGrants by **Tuesday, January 2, 2018 by 5:00 p.m.** Eastern Time.
- **Revision Period:** Applications with written feedback will be returned to potential grantees on December 20 by 5:00 p.m. for re-work.
- **Deadline #2:** Revised applications must be returned to Volunteer West Virginia in eGrants by **12:00 p.m. on Friday, December 29, 2017.**
- **Final Clarification Period:** Grant applicants must designate a staff contact to address final clarifications **Tuesday, January 9-Friday January 12.**
- **Application Notification:** Successful applicants will be notified **by Monday, May 15, 2018.**
