

• The event is hosted annually by Volunteer West Virginia.





Nomination Form & Eligibility



Nomination Form Information

 An online nomination form can be found at https://volunteer.wv.gov/

The deadline for nominations is March 8th

No essay is required.



Nomination Form Overview

All nominations to be completed online on our website.

Let's check it out!



Eligibility

 Except for Lifetime Achievement nominations must include significant volunteer activities in 2023.

Posthumous nominations are not eligible

• Awards are not always given in all categories. More than one award may be made per category.

 No more than three nominations can be submitted by the same nominator.



Eligibility

 Individuals and groups that have received an award in the last ten years are not eligible for consideration.

 Employees and members of the board of Volunteer
 WV and the Office of the Governor are not eligible to receive an award and may not submit a nomination.



Nomination Form Tips

How To Write a Winning Nomination





1) Answer all of the questions.

- Answer each question in detail.
- We would recommend writing 2 3 paragraphs per question.
- Each question will be scored by the review panel.
- Well-written nomination forms with supporting materials score higher with the review panel.



2) Paint a clear picture of your nominee.

 Please remember that the reviewers' only knowledge about the nominee's volunteer efforts is through the material submitted with the nomination.



3) Do your homework.

Take time to collect information about your nominee.

 Collect stories and data to paint a clear picture about your nominee's impact in the community.



5) Provide a wide variety of supporting materials.

- You can submit up to 5 pages of supporting materials.
- Make the most of your 5 pages This information should add to your nomination.
- Highlight your nominees' accomplishments and explain what makes this nominee particularly special.
- Examples: An impact story, letters of support from individuals that were served, fellow volunteers, and staff, newspaper articles, photos.



Supporting Materials Example

- 1. A letter from a student
- 2. A statement from a fellow volunteer
- An impact story about the program from the High School Principal
- 4. A photo collage
- 5. A newspaper article about the impact of the volunteer activity



5) Save your work

 We strongly recommend you prepare your answers in a Word document and copy them into the online form when you are ready to submit your nomination.



Other Information

- All nominees will receive a certificate from the Governor
- We will post a list of recipients on our website by May 15th.
- Nominations are due by March 8th.
