Funds from these agencies can be used as part of your grantee share budget, based on the conditions listed below and subject to the terms and intent of both CNCS and the other federal funding sources. AmeriCorps State grantees do not need to take additional steps to secure match letters from these organizations, at this time; however, if your program is approved for funding and utilizes these funds as match, please download and keep the authorizing materials in your grant record. The Commission will accept these sources unless an agency produces a policy which contradicts this directive, in that case, existing federal statute takes precedence.
